Jazz Camp 2012 (Wednesday January 18 – Sunday 22) brings together motivated young jazz musicians from all around Australia and overseas. It offers the chance to work with other like-minded students in a friendly and supportive environment. We go out of our way to ensure that every Jazz Camper is safe, happy and included. Our music faculty is backed up by a team of counsellors dedicated to helping everyone get the most out of their Jazz camp experience. Alumni of Jazz Camp include a who's who of top Australian jazz artists.

World-class Tutors

At Jazz Camp, students work with a world-class faculty of expert tutors. Acclaimed drummer and inspirational educator John Morrison is the camp's musical director and patron. For any student serious about learning to play jazz, or achieving new heights of excellence, and having a great time, Jazz Camp is the place!

Beginner to Advanced

For students ages 11 - 19 at all levels of jazz playing experience: beginner, intermediate and advanced. Students are grouped according to their experience as improvising jazz musicians to ensure everyone works at a level just right for them.

We suggest students have at least two or three years experience on their instrument (or around grade 3 - 4 level) to get the most out of Jazz Camp. The camp is suitable for any instrument, including singers and strings. Vocalists work intensively with Jacki Cooper through a specially designed program. More advanced vocalists have the opportunity to learn improvisation techniques and to work with a small jazz ensemble.

Final Concert

The camp ends with a final concert performance by all the students. It will be at North Sydney Boys' High School, Falcon St, Crows Nest starting 4:30pm on Sunday January 22. Students and all their gear are driven to the concert venue in coaches. Parents and friends are welcome at the concert. Entry is free.

Terms & Conditions

All bookings are subject to the terms and conditions set out below. Registration and payment indicates acceptance of all the following. Applicants over the age of 18 years accept the following on their own behalf. You consent to release Jazz Workshop Australia Pty Ltd (JWA), and all Jazz Camp 2012 staff from any claim or liability arising directly or indirectly from the Jazz Camp activities.

You indemnify JWA against responsibility for any accident, loss or injury suffered by your child/children during the course of the Jazz Camp activities.

If a representative of JWA or Jazz Camp 2012 should at any time consider that your child/children require/s medical or hospital treatment, you consent to them obtaining this at your expense.

The cost of the camp is \$715 AUD before close of business September 1, 2011 (early bird special, full advance payment), or \$756 AUD after September 1, 2011. (inc. GST).

This includes participation in all relevant sessions, the supply of a camp kit, all meals and drinks, transport to the final concert venue, plus shared accommodation.

Full advance payment is required to complete registration. Before December 24, 2011 payments are fully refundable less a \$50 service fee. From December 25, 2011 to January 10, 2012 payments received are 50% refundable. After January 10, 2012, payments are non refundable.

All payments must be completed in full by January 10, 2012. The early bird discount is only available on full payments completed by September 1, 2011. JWA reserves the right to refuse a registration due to limited availability. The right is also reserved to decline, to accept, cancel or withdraw any camp participant prior to or during the camp.

If your child/children has/have special dietary requirements or a pre-existing illness or medical condition, you must provide full details on the separate medical information form. You consent to pay for any damage, whether deliberate or accidental, caused by you/your child to property owned by JWA or used by JWA and supplied by alternate parties (e.g. Accommodation, Vehicles) or property owned by other program participants. All replacement and or repair costs are the responsibility of the individual/s responsible for the damage.

JWA is not responsible for individuals' personal musical instruments or property. Insurance is suggested for valuable instruments.

Information supplied to JWA will remain confidential and will not be made available to any third party. Photographs of camp activities may be taken by an authorized photographer and may be used in future promotional material or publications solely by JWA.
